- All-purpose cleaners
- Aerosol cans
- Pesticides/Herbicides
- Glues/Adhesives
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Mercury thermometers
- Photographic chemicals
- Smoke detectors
- Paints/Stains*
- Motor Oil/Lubricants*
- Batteries*

- Containers over 5 gallons in size
- Ammunition

- Electronics*
- Tires*
- Unknown or unlabeled substances

* Other Disposal Options

- **Recycling Used oil:** many oil change shops or auto parts stores (such as AutoZone, Checker and Jiffy Lubes, Walmart and others) accept up to 5 gallons of non-contaminated oil free of charge.
- **Batteries, tires:** Solid Waste Districts
- **Old electronics, tvs, computers, etc.:** Solid Waste Districts
- **Usable Paint, building supplies, metal, operating appliances:** Habitat for Humanity (801-344-8527 or www.habitatuc.org)

How To Pack Your Wastes: Do not mix wastes. If possible, leave materials in original containers with labels intact, or mark containers if labels are missing. Be sure all containers are capped or sealed. Containers must be deposited with waste materials, they cannot be returned. Transport in a cardboard box lined with newspaper.
